Jammin' Food Fest is scheduled for May 17 in the Community Park. There will be live music throughout the day, food trucks and a beer/wine garden for the hungry or thirsty.

2025 HEAVY TRASH PICK-UP

The Town's Public Works Crews will be collecting heavy trash items FOUR TIMES THIS YEAR (see dates below). This month, they will be out picking up your heavy trash items from Monday, May 12th through Friday, May 16th. Please place all heavy trash curbside. Crews will not go onto private property to make collections. This service is provided to our residential customers only. Crews will pick up trash by item type during the week and will have all trash picked up by the end of the day on Friday, May 16th, 2025. Brush and limbs must be tied in bundles no longer than four feet in length. To ensure removal, all heavy trash should be placed curbside no later than 7:00 am on Friday, May 16th, 2025. Due to State laws governing the operation of the Shenandoah County Landfill, the Town is unable to remove old TVs, computers, tires, or hazardous materials such as pesticides, herbicides, paint, paint thinner, etc. For instructions on where to take the aforementioned items, you may call the Shenandoah County Landfill at 540-984-8573. The Virginia Museum of the Civil War at New Market Battlefield State Historical Park will host numerous living historians who will tell the story of the battle through programs and presentations designed to educate and entertain. Visit with the Society of Civil War Surgeons and delve into the aftermath of battle and the people responsible for caring for the wounded. Take time to visit the military camps and ask what daily life was like for Civil War soldiers. Watch and learn military drills, and experience live black powder demos. Explore the home built by Jacob and Sarah Bushong where they sheltered with their family as the heaviest fighting raged outside their door. Author Karl Rhodes will be here to present on his book "Peggy's War." Discounted admission rate of \$5 per person available to New Market residents ages 6 and up, children 5 and under are free.
