7 The New Market Town Council met in the Council Chambers of the Arthur L.  
8 Hildreth, Jr. Municipal Building on Monday, July 2, 2018 with the following members

18 Mayor Bradley called the meeting to order and established a quorum with all  
19 members present. The Pledge of Allegiance was recited in unison. Mayor Bradley  
20 welcomed all visitors and guests.

24 **Mr. Hughes made a motion to approve the agenda as presented. Mr. Wymer**  
25 **seconded the motion which carried on a unanimous voice vote.**

29 **Mr. Alex Berryman, Town Planner –**

30 Mr. Berryman gave a power point presentation which explained water/sewer text  
31 amendments to Chapter 62 of the Town Code. The presentation also summarized a draft  
32 of the Town of New Market's Fats, Oils and Grease Program. Mr. Berryman's goal was  
33 to make council aware of the proposed changes to Chapter 62 of the Town Code and of  
34 the Fats, Oils, and Grease Program. Council may be asked to take action on these two  
35 items at future council meetings. A copy of Mr. Berryman's presentation is on file with  
36 the minutes.

40 The first action item was the election of a Vice-Mayor. Mr. Hughes nominated  
41 Mrs. Harkness as Vice-Mayor. When no other nominations were made, **Mr. Palmer**

60 reschedule a council meeting to the next business day in the event of hazardous  
61 conditions. **Mr. Palmer made a motion to adopt Resolution #230: A Resolution**  
62 **regarding the time of regular meetings and inclement weather meeting times. Mr.**  
63 **Wymer seconded the motion.** A brief discussion ensued regarding whether 6:30 p.m.  
64 was the best time for council meetings. It was the general consensus of council that 6:30  
65 p.m. was the best time for regular monthly meetings. **The motion carried on the**




